Enabling work: Acting as social integrators and inspiring hope among workers and companies.



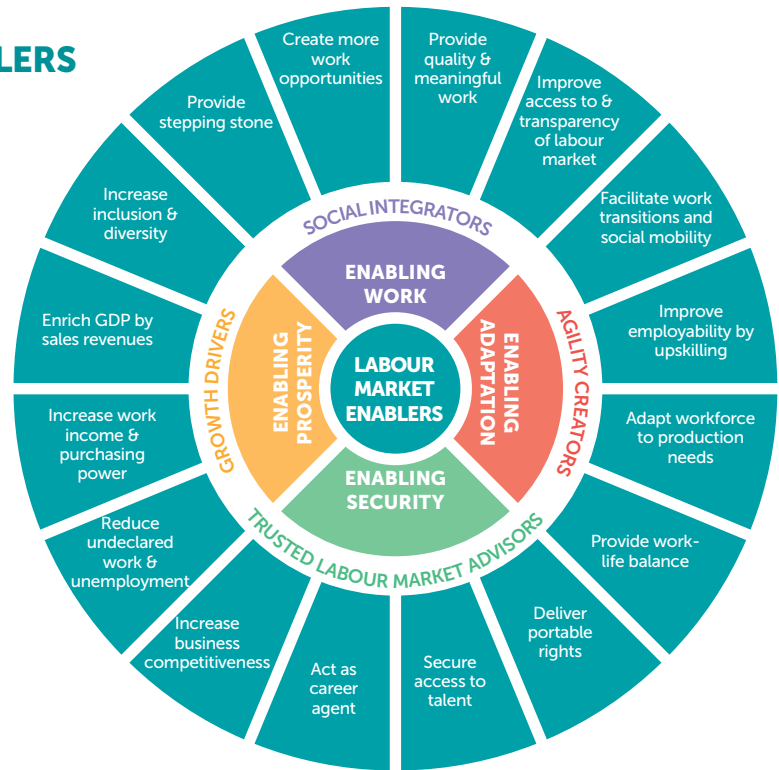
Enabling adaptation: Working as agility creators and building stakeholder confidence.

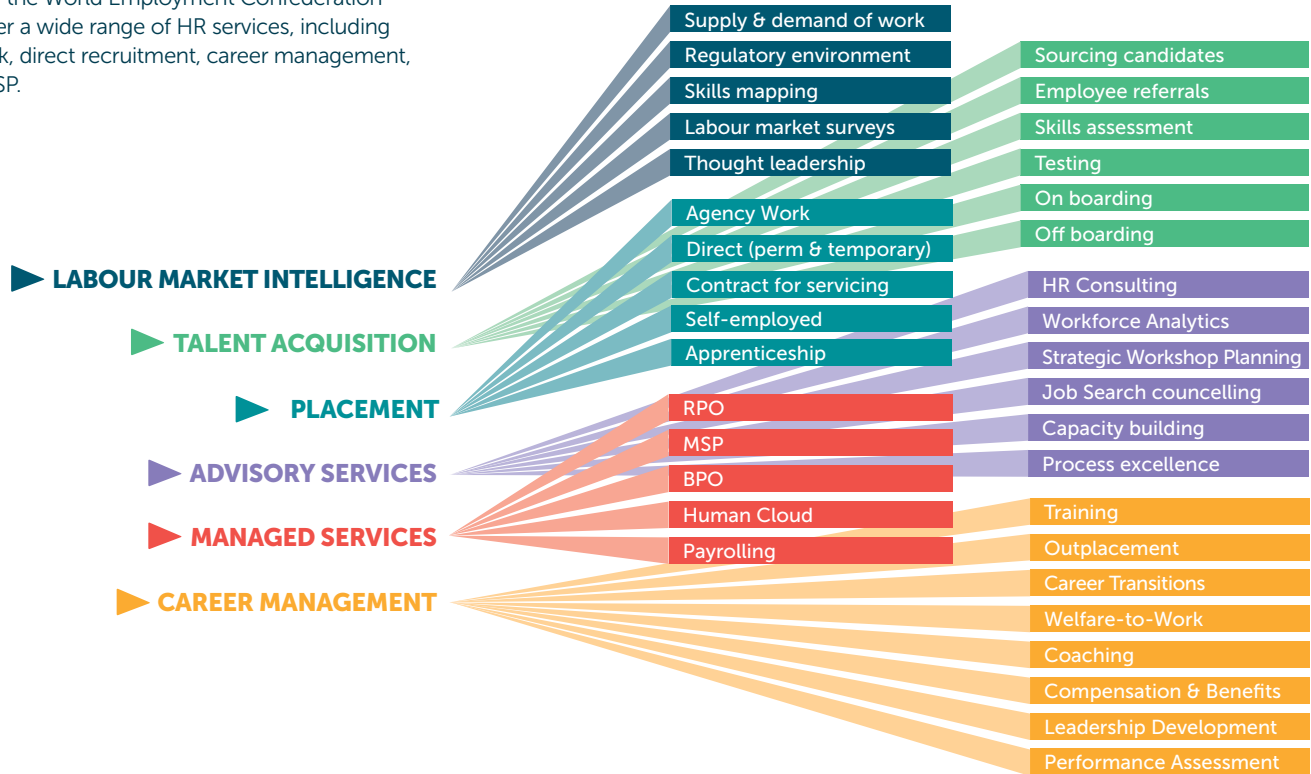

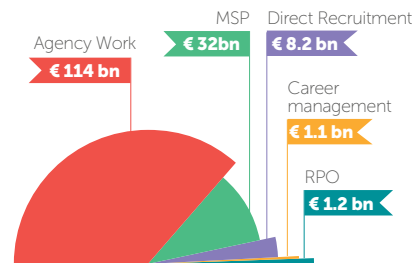

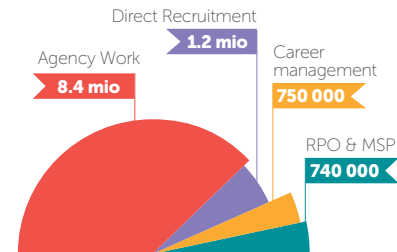
